Session 1: July 5-9 Animals Around Us- On The Go - Each day of this camp meets somewhere new, check online for details! Explore the animals that live or visit the land and sea of Santa Cruz. Explorer Trip to Seymour Center and Natural Bridges State Park. \$200

Session 2: July 11-15 Travels in Time- From the Ohlone to the building of the boardwalk we will learn about the history of Santa Cruz. Explorer Trip to Boardwalk and Natural History Museum. Thursday-Fall Creek/Pool. \$250

Session 3: July 18-22 Project KAPOW!- Campers take care of their watershed by removing trash along the river and at the ocean. Explorer trip via train to Boardwalk and Seabright Beach. Thursday at Highlands Park. \$200

Session 4: July 25-29 Hearts and Art- We will work our hearts and do daily art on our down time. Daily yoga, hikes, jogs, swimming, and games will keep our hearts happy. Ceramics, beading, painting, collages, charcoal sketches, and nature journals. Art Show on Friday. Explorer Trip to Point Lobos. Thursday trip to SLV track/pool. \$250

Session 5: August 1-5 Project KAPOW! #2- A repeat since the river will need it! The Pack will spend the week learning about our local watershed and the water cycle while taking care of the environment. Explorer trip via train to SC beaches. Thursday Trip to Fall Creek/Pool. \$200
